Successful application to Department of Recreation & Sport Infrastructure Project

Port Elliot Bowling Club has been advised of the success of our recent application for Dept of Recreation & Sport funding to upgrade current floodlighting on A & B Greens to LED.

The Grant funding will be matched by club funds. The project which will be fitted into the club maintenance schedule over the winter break will vastly improve bowling conditions for Night Owls next season, resolving poor lighting and shadow issues.

It will also give opportunity to develop other evening programs, e.g. twilight games and opportunities which attract more local people to come out and get active and possibly run Championships at times convenient to workers.

Importantly, LED lighting will also be more cost effective, energy efficient and environmentally responsible, emitting less carbon.

We are grateful to Rebekha Sharkie, MP for Mayo, Phil Dodd, PEBC Patron, Port Elliot Town & Foreshore Improvement Association, Alexandrina Council, Bowls SA and also to club members who gave written support for our application. David Basham, State Member for Finniss was unable to give written support since funding sought was in his electorate.


