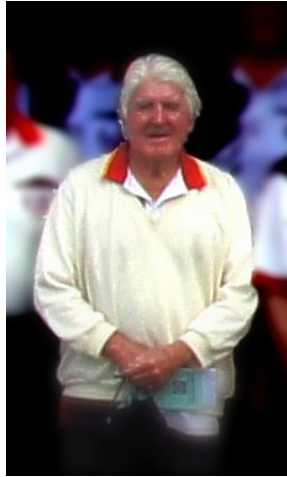

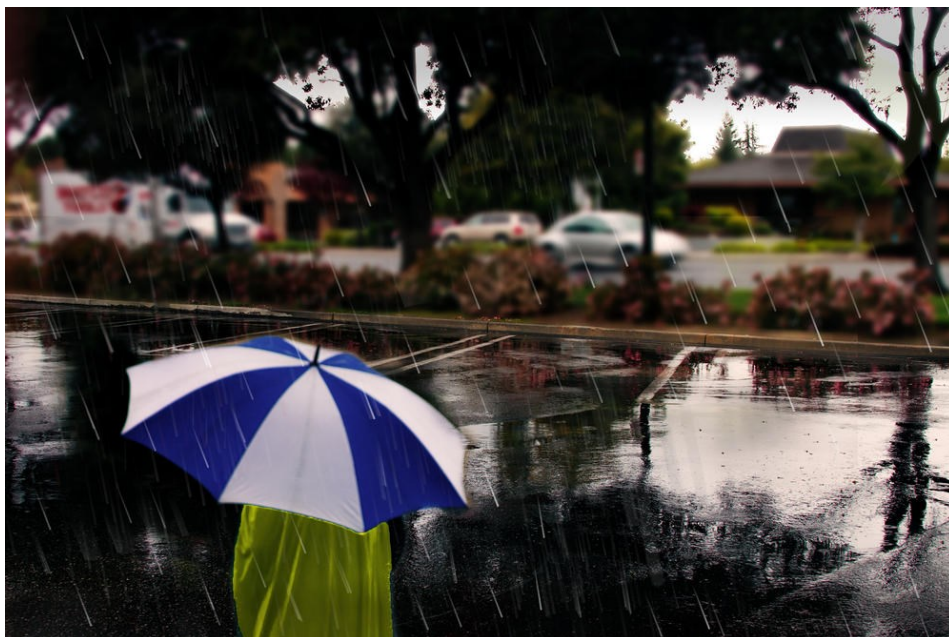

with 28 teams, a full complement.**

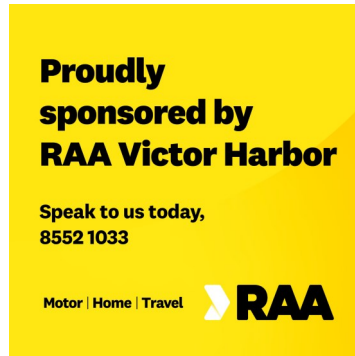
Due to inclement weather, rain and sea fog play was abandoned.

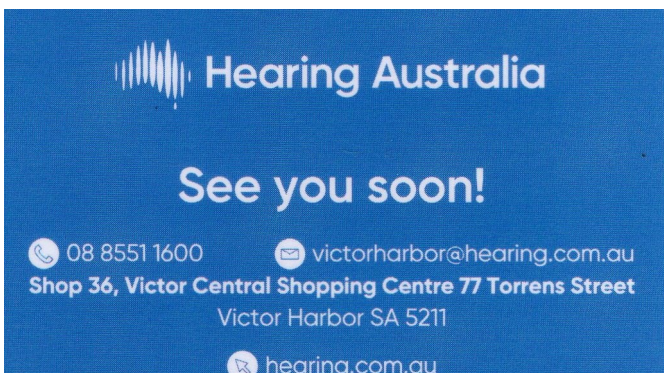


The Sun Gods looked down on us Wednesday 2nd November allowing us to play, we were lucky that there was hardly any wind or rain.

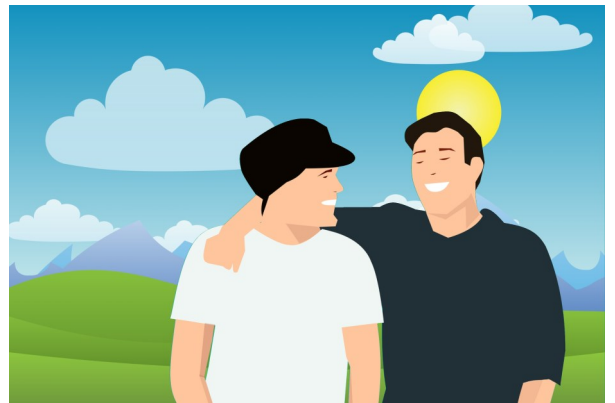
